What will I do as Vice-President?

What skills do I have?

- // *JCR Publicity Officer, January 2015 - January 2016.* Particular highlights were setting up the Sidney Sussex College JCR Instagram and introducing a co-opted photographer role on the JCR. I really loved being on SSCSU, and I'm enthusiastic to continue making a difference.
- // *Sidney Sussex May Ball Infrastructural Logistics Officer, June 2015 - Ongoing.* Negotiation with college and teamwork to pull off a successful ball. I have sole responsibility for the risk assessment and master plan, meaning I already have a good relationship with college authorities.
- // *European Society Social Secretary, June 2015 – Ongoing.* Requires cultural sensitivity, organisation and commitment. This term I have organised film screenings, formals and a cultural exchange trip to Paris
- // *Impact Officer, Cambridge International Development Conference, May – November 2015.* Helped to organise a successful university wide conference, ensuring that we met our intended outcomes. This emphasis is one I would bring to the role of Vice-Pres
- // *Cambridge Access Scheme, January 2015.* My experiences here mean that I am passionate about access, and determined to support other officers in improving the many programmes college runs
- // *Cambridge for Europe, January 2015 – Ongoing.* Involved in a project to track sources of EU funding in the University, I am already involved in information collection processes similar to that which CUSU engages in every day. I will develop my expertise to forward the interests of Sidney Students.
